Our response to COVID-19

Safety has always been a core value of Stuff-a-Sackpack. Each year we diligently screen donations to ensure safety for our valley's teens. 2020 will be no exception. In response to COVID-19, the Stuff-a-Sackpack team will be taking the following precautions during turn-ins:

- Masks/face shields
- Hand sanitization between each exchange
- Turn-in stations that adhere to 6' social distancing
- Contactless turn-in process (curbside/from car by request)
- Application of disinfectant to the exterior of every sackpack
- Use of disinfectant wipes on loose donations

In addition:

Each Stuff-a-Sackpack team member will be pre-screened daily for COVID-19 symptoms/exposure prior to volunteering during turn-in events.

A pre-screening email will be sent on Friday and Saturday during the week of Stuff-a-Sackpack turn-ins to each person who has signed up to stuff sackpacks.

All boxed sackpacks and donations will sit, undisturbed, for a minimum of 24-72 hours prior to delivery to our partner schools on Monday, December 7.

2020 turn-in dates have been adjusted to allocate an extra week for our partner schools to distribute sackpacks and donations in the way that is safest for their students.
